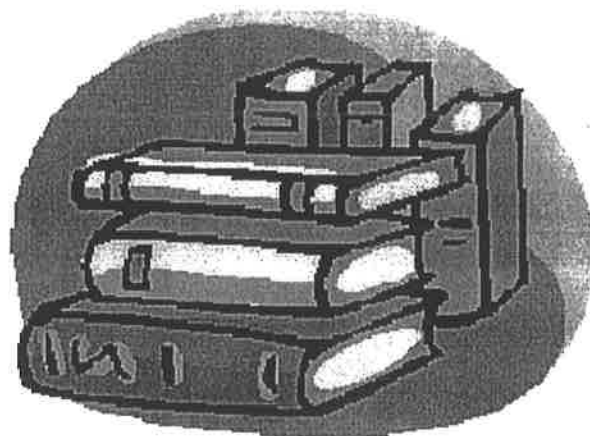

Build Your Reading on *myON*

BOOK BY BOOK

Dear Parents and Guardians,

This summer your children have the opportunity to read on *myON* anytime they choose. All Meriden public elementary schools now have unlimited access to *myON* throughout the year. *MyON* is an award-winning literacy program with over 5,000 online books that can be read at school, home, or anywhere there is access to a digital device. *MyON* provides a personalized dashboard that allows students and parents to keep daily track of all myON activities including: student reading levels, words read, books read, quiz scores, and much more.

Directions to log onto the myON program

1. Go to myon.com
2. Click on Log In now
3. Type the school name: Nathan Hale Elementary (make sure it says Meriden Public School District)
4. Username: Student lunch number
5. Password: Student lunch number
6. Click Sign In and begin

Your child's student number is the same as his/her lunch number.

We are so fortunate to have this opportunity to use myON to support Meriden's elementary students as they build their reading skills throughout the year, and especially this summer.
